

Information about the Form I-20

The Form I-20 is the Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant (F-1) Student Status for academic and language programs. The Form I-20 is required to apply for an F-1 student visa and for the port of entry into the U.S. In order to receive an I-20, students must be accepted to Westcliff University and complete the application for an I-20.

In order to receive an I-20, Westcliff University requires the following:

- 1. A completed I-20 Request (Affidavit)
- 2. Proof of financial support: student's and/or sponsor's funds (i.e., bank statement, bank letter, etc.)
- 3. Proof of English proficiency
- 4. Passport
- 5. I-94 (if applicable)

Upon receipt of all required documents, the Form I-20 can be generated via the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS). Incomplete documents could result in a delay of the student's I-20. Once the I-20 has been generated, the shipping department will send the I-20 to the student by mail.

Upon receiving a Form I-20, students must:

- 1. Pay the SEVIS I-901 fee at www.fmjfee.com
- 2. Apply for the F-1 student visa
- 3. Make an appointment with the U.S. Embassy or Consulate in their home country
- 4. Be prepared to present the following at the visa interview:
 - a. Form I-20
 - b. Receipt of SEVIS I-901 fee payment
 - c. Form DS-160, Nonimmigrant Visa Application with payment receipt
 - d. Additional documents may be required and/or recommended:
 - Acceptance letter
 - Admissions checklist
 - Academic transcripts
 - Proof of English proficiency
 - Affidavit of support and financial evidence
 - Ties to student's home country
 - Receipt of advance tuition payment (to demonstrate financial stability and commitment to your education)
