Before beginning the application process, please read the entire application packet. Applications are accepted year-round but must be submitted at least <u>one month</u> prior to the program start date. An Application for Admission must be submitted with the Scholarship application to be eligible.

Description:

The Westcliff University Scholarship Program is intended to promote high academic achievement among new entering students in our Business and Education programs. The Westcliff University Scholarship promotes continued academic success. Students selected as recipients will receive a partial tuition scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on academic merit such as student G.P.A., standardized test scores, extracurricular activities, etc.

Scholarship Requirements:

To be eligible for this award, applicants must have completed at least a high school diploma for bachelor level programs and a bachelor diploma for master level programs with a grade point average of at least 2.0 on a scale of 4.0.

Unless exceptional circumstances exist, scholarship recipients are required to maintain continuous enrollment and maintain good academic standing each semester during the school year. Failure to maintain good academic standing **OR** continuous enrollment requirements will result in the automatic and permanent forfeiture of the scholarship award.
